ಮಹಾತ್ಮ ಗಾಂಧಿ ನರೇಗಾ ಯೋಜನೆಯಡಿ ಮೊಬೈಲ್ ಮಾನಿಟರಿಂಗ್ ಸಿಸ್ಟಂನ್ನು ಅನುಷ್ಠಾನಗೊಳಿಸುವ ಬಗ್ಗೆ ಉಲ್ಲೇಖ (1) ರ ಭಾರತ ಸರ್ಕಾರದ ಗ್ರಾಮೀಣಾಭಿವೃದ್ಧಿ ಮಂತ್ರಾಲಯದ ಪತ್ರಗಳಲ್ಲಿ ನೋಡುವ ಸೂಚನೆಗಳತ್ತ ಗಮನಹರಿಸಲು ಮತ್ತೊಮ್ಮೆ ತಿಳಿಸಿದೆ. ಕರ್ನಾಟಕ ರಾಜ್ಯದ ಎನ್.ಜಿ.ಪಿ. (Nirmal Grama Puraskar) ಅವಾರ್ಡ್ ಪಟ್ಟಿಯಲ್ಲಿರುವ 28 ಜಿಲ್ಲೆಗಳಲ್ಲಿನ 1070 ಗ್ರಾಮ ಪಂಚಾಯತಿಗಳಲ್ಲಿ (ಪಟ್ಟಿ ಲಗತ್ತಿಸಿದೆ) ಮೊಬೈಲ್ ಮಾನಿಟರಿಂಗ್ ಸಿಸ್ಟಂನ್ನು ಅಳವಡಿಸಿಕೊಳ್ಳುವ ಸಂಬಂಧ ಅನುಸರಿಸಬೇಕಾದ ಅಗತ್ಯ ಕ್ರಮಗಳನ್ನು ಕೂಡಲೇ ಕೈಗೊಳ್ಳಲು ಮತ್ತೊಮ್ಮೆ ತಿಳಿಸಿದೆ. ಈ ಯೋಜನೆಯಡಿ ಖರೀದಿಸುವ ಟ್ಯಾಬ್ಲೆಟ್ ನ ಕನಿಷ್ಠ ಮಾದರಿಯ ವಿವರಗಳ ಅನುಬಂಧ ಈ ಪತ್ರದೊಂದಿಗೆ ಲಗತ್ತಿಸಿದೆ.

ನಿರ್ದಿಷ್ಟ ಪಡಿಸಿದ ಟ್ಯಾಬ್ಲೆಟ್ ಖರೀದಿಯನ್ನು ರೂ. 10000/- ಗಳ ಮಿತಿಯಲ್ಲಿ ಕೈಗೊಳ್ಳುವುದು. ಭಾರತ ಸರ್ಕಾರದಿಂದ ಇದಕ್ಕಾಗಿ ಶೇಕಡ 5 ರ ಬಾಬು ರೂ. 35 ಲಕ್ಷ ರೂ. ಬಡುಗಡೆಯಾಗುತ್ತದೆ. ಜಿಲ್ಲಾ ಪಂಚಾಯತಿಯಿಂದ ಹಣ ಬಡುಗಡೆಗೆ ಬೇಡಿಕೆ ಸಲ್ಲಿಸಿದ್ದಲ್ಲಿ ಪ್ರಥಮ ಆದ್ಯತೆಯ ಮೇರೆಗೆ ಸಂಬಂಧಿಸಿದ ಬಡುಗಡೆ ಮಾಡಲಾಗುವುದು. ನಾಮಲಿ ಖರೀದಿಗೆ ಜಿಲ್ಲಾ ಪಂಚಾಯತಿಯ ಮುಖ್ಯ ಕಾರ್ಯನಿರ್ವಾಹಕ ಅಧಿಕಾರಿಗಳೇ ಅಗತ್ಯ ಕ್ರಮ ವಹಿಸುವುದು. ಉಳಿಕೆ ಹಣವನ್ನು ಯೋಜನೆಯ ಶೇಕಡ 6 ರ ಅಡಕತಾತ್ಮಕ ವೆಚ್ಚದಿಂದ ಭರಿಸಲು ಹಣ ಬಡುಗಡೆ ಮಾಡಲಾಗುವುದು.

ಕೇಂದ್ರ ಸರ್ಕಾರ ಉಲ್ಲೇಖಿತ ಪತ್ರ ಸಂಖ್ಯೆ: J-11011/2/2008-MGNREGA dated: 31-10-2014 MMS ಅನುಷ್ಠಾನದ ಬಗ್ಗೆ ಸ್ವಯಂ ವೇದ್ಯವಾಗಿದೆ. ಸದಲ ಪತ್ರ ಕಂಟಕ್ 4 ರಂತೆ ಈ ಉಪಕರಣ (device) buy-operate-own model ಪದ್ಧತಿಯಂತೆ ಖರೀದಿಸಬೇಕಾಗುತ್ತದೆ.

a) Buy:

1. The device will be bought by the functionary upfront from the market. The functionary is free to buy any device which satisfies the specifications given in the Annesure. There will be no centralized procurement of the device.
2. The PO shall check and satisfy himself that:
 - ✓ The device is new (purchased after the announcement of this scheme) and is genuine instrument.
 - ✓ The IMEI number printed on the label under the battery is the same as the IMEI number reported on the phone box.

✓ Covered by at least 12 months signed warranty.

3. After this, the PO has to register the device on NREGASoft online along with the specifications and bill/vouchers. After this, the PO will generate a pay order for reimbursement of the entire cost of the device or Rs. 10,000 whichever is lower to the functionary.
4. 50% of this amount will be the subsidy by the Central Government; and the balance 50% will be recovered from the functionary in 10 equal interest-free instalments.

b) Operate:

1. All functionaries who come under the scheme would be trained in installing and operating the modules.
2. The functionary will operate the device duly installing the 8 modules (or other modules if needed).
 - i. Planning module: captures photographs of all new worksites; planning process.
 - ii. Demand capture during Rozgar divas
 - iii. Work allocation:
 - iv. Generation of eMuster
 - v. Daily attendance: at the worksite by GRS
 - vi. Measurement (to be used by the Technical Assistant) with GSM
 - vii. Check-measurement (to be used by the Jr Engineer) with GSM
 - viii. Aadhaar seeding module
3. Each device shall be provided with a SIM card that operates on GSM/GPRS, meeting the operational cost from the 6% Administrative costs of the programme.
4. NIC will arrange to synchronise these devices and will be uploaded onto the central server as and when connectivity is available. This will allow the device to function even if there is no GPRS connectivity
5. The device has to be operated in such a way that input of the data using the modules shall be done only using the device. In the event non-operation of the device as per the prescribed regularity, the entire cost of the device, the PO shall recover from the functionary.
6. The functionary would be responsible for the accuracy of the data captured using the device.

c) Own:

1. On recovery of the 50% of the cost of the device, the ownership of the device will transfer to the functionary.
2. Safekeeping and maintenance shall be the responsibility of the functionaries.
3. In case any field functionary leaves his/her duty in the middle without paying the total recovery amount, the PO shall seize his mobile until the respective field functionary pays back the recovery amount completely. In case the field functionary fails to pay back the remaining amount, the PO shall retain the mobile and assign it to the incumbent,
4. If the functionary demits office within 12 months from the date of registration of the device, the entire cost of the device shall be recovered before relieving her/him.

5. In order to secure the intrest certificates of the functionary shall be kept in the safe custody of the PO till the total amount die form the functionary is recovered.

Subject: MGNREGS – implementation of the **Mobile Monitoring System.**

Madam/Sir,

The MGNREGS has been implemented as an IT-driven programme linking all the processes to the NREGASoft. With a view to improve the monitoring of the MGNREGS and provide a real time data visibility, a project for providing mobile interface to the NREGASoft was sanctioned in 10,000 Gram Panchayats in the Country. The first instalment funds have been released to (9) States which came forward to implement the scheme vide Ltr.No.LK-11011/2/2008-MGNREGA/TS-NREGASoft dated 31st March 2014. However, the scheme could not be grounded since the Aakash-IV tablet promoted by the Department of Electronics and IT (which was prescribed in the scheme and in the sanction order) could not be made available in the market.

2. The Government has reviewed the matter further and decided to duly amend the earlier scheme and extend the Mobile Monitoring System (MMS) to all the GPs and technical/supervisory personnel involved in MGNREGS in the Country, in phases. The Mobile monitoring system uses the existing GSM/GPRS connectivity and links it with the NREGASoft central server, thereby providing access to data at the village level.

3. The MMS scheme would operate as follows:

a) **Objectives:** The objectives of the MMS scheme are as follows:

- i. To empower Gram Panchayats and implementation agencies with live data from the worksites
- ii. To allow an online and real-time updation of database
- iii. Allow real-time visibility of the data for complete transparency
- iv. Location of assets with geo-tagging for easy verification

b) **Eligibility:** All Gram/Block Panchayats implementing MGNREGA are eligible under the scheme to get a Mobile/Tablet PC along with GSM/GPRS connectivity.

c) **Identification:**

- a. All the 10,000 Blocks/GPs identified in the pilot project (sanctioned earlier) will automatically be brought into the scheme.
- b. Apart from this, each of the 2,500 IPPE Blocks can identify 10 GPs per Block (25,000 GPs) for being brought under the scheme.
- c. The technical assistants and the engineering personnel in these blocks, who are responsible for measurement, shall be brought under the scheme, for electronic measurements and uploading site photos.
- d. The identification of GPs should be done by the State Governments before 31st Jan 2015.

- d) **Procurement of the Device:** The State Governments will decide who will procure the devices and what shall be the modalities for such procurement. They should exercise due diligence and procure the devices as per their respective procurement/financial rules.
- e) The State Government is responsible for maintaining an inventory of these devices, and for maintenance of the devices in good condition. Each device shall also be provided with a SIM card that operates on GSM/GPRS, meeting the operational cost from the 6% Administrative costs of the programme.
- f) The Programme Officer of each participating Block should register all the devices after verifying that the IMEI number printed on the label under the battery is the same as the IMEI number reported on the phone box and is covered by at least 12 month signed warranty. After this, the PO has to register the device on NREGASoft online along with the specifications.
- g) The Government of India contribution for the device shall be limited to Rs. 10,000.
- h) All functionaries who come under the scheme should be trained in installing and operating the modules.
- i) The functionary will operate the device duly installing the 8 modules (or other modules as communicated from time to time) which are made operational by the NIC.
- i. Planning module: captures photographs of all new worksites; planning process.
 - ii. Demand capture: during Rozgar divas
 - iii. Work allocation:
 - iv. Generation of eMuster
 - v. Daily attendance: at the worksite by GRS
 - vi. Measurement (to be used by the Technical Assistant) with GSM
 - vii. Check-measurement (to be used by the Jr Engineer) with GSM
 - viii. Aadhaar seeding module
- j) NIC will arrange to synchronise these devices with the central server with a two-way communication.
- k) The data will be saved on the device and will be uploaded onto the central server as and when connectivity is available. This will allow the device to function even if there is no GPRS connectivity.
- l) The device has to be operated in such a way that input of the data using the modules shall be done only using the device. In the event of non-operation of the device as per the prescribed regularity, the entire cost of the device, the PO shall recover from the functionary.
- m) The functionary who is handling the device on behalf of the GP/Block would be responsible for the accuracy of the data captured using the device.

4. The Central Government contribution towards devices for 25,000 GPs, not exceeding Rs. 25 Cr will be released to the State Governments in 2 instalments, over and above the 6% administrative costs to the State Government. This will be in addition to the release made for 10,000 GPs through the UIDAI assistance.

5. You are requested to identify intimate the list of Blocks/GPs in which the scheme would be implemented immediately so that funds can be released for the procurement of devices. You may also plan for training of the functionaries in these GPs/Blocks in consultation with NIC, so that the system will get operationalised from 1st April 2015.
